## Certifications recognised by REMADE®

#### Foreword

Pursuant to the provisions of the TR REMADE® Producers ("Requirements for REMADE certification"), point 4.3.2.1., the certifications listed below are considered recognised.

The certifications listed below are deemed consistent and suitable to provide evidence of the origin of materials obtained from waste recycling, recovery and/or by-products, according to the traceability criteria underlying the REMADE certification scheme.

The certification provided by the Company shall be checked for its relevance to the product subject to REMADE certification. It must also be in force at the time the certification is issued.

In order to be eligible for REMADE certification, the certificate shall explicitly state the recycled, recovered material and/or by-products content of the product to which it refers. In the case of multi-material products, the content of recycled, recovered material and/or by-products in each component shall be explicitly stated.

The list shall be updated periodically by REMADE.

The list is not intended to be exhaustive and may be verified on a case-by-case basis.
